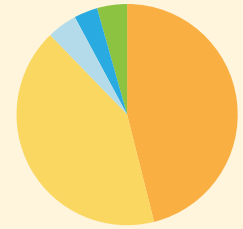

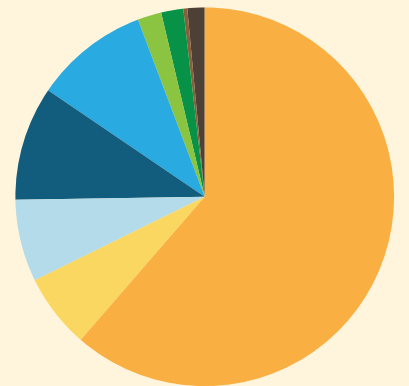
## EXPENSES BY FUNCTION

Camp Encourage continues to focus efforts on ensuring that more of our community members—especially our immediate neighbors in Jackson County—have access to our services.

As our new Strategic Plan guides us toward a 30% increase in programming in 2026, we know that it **would not be feasible without your generosity** and the support of our community. **Together**, we will ensure that more local youth discover that Camp Encourage is a space where each is welcomed, is loved, and feels at home. Where we are reminded how essential it is that we love ourselves, celebrate exactly who we are, and gather in a space where others do the same.
